The Tolls Act, 2011 (Act No. 14 of 2011)

The Tolls Regulations, 2016

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in sections 10 and 25 of the Tolls Act, 2011, and in consultation with the Minister responsible for finance, the following Regulations are made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as Tolls Regulations, 2016.

Title

2. In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires—

Interpretation

- "bulk toll discount" means a wholesale price discount by the toll distributors or toll vendors applicable to bulk purchases of tolls;
- "local user" means a road user driving a Zambian registered vehicle domiciled within a ten kilometer radius of an inland toll point, excluding a port of entry;
- "local user discount" means a toll levied on a local user to a specific facility for a specified period of time;
- "toll" has the meaning assigned to it in the Act;
- "toll collector" has the meaning assigned to it in the Act;
- "toll distributor or toll vendor" means a third party reseller of tolls who buys tolls in bulk and sells to road users at consumer retail price;
- "toll point" means a point designated for the collection of tolls under regulation 3; and
- "toll road" has the meaning assigned to it in the Act.
- 3. The border posts, places, roads and ports of entry specified in the First Schedule are designated toll points for the purposes of these Regulations.

Designation of toll points

Payment of toll

- 4. (1) A driver of a vehicle specified in the Second Schedule shall, at the time of passing through a toll point, pay to a toll collector the appropriate toll prescribed in that Schedule in Zambian kwacha equivalent in respect of the vehicle.
 - (2) A driver of a vehicle may—
 - (a) at the time of passing through a toll point, pay in advance the appropriate toll prescribed in the Schedule in respect of the vehicle for another toll point within the route to be taken by the driver; or
 - (b) apply to pay in advance to a toll collector for one or more toll points within a ten kilometer radius of that driver's domicility.

Local user discount rate

5. A toll distributor or toll vendor who buys tolls in bulk shall buy the tolls at the bulk discount rate prescribed in Fourth Schedule.

Revocation of SI No. 73 of 2013

6. The Tolls Regulations, 2013 are revoked.
