**The Road Traffic (Obligatory Test Certificate)
(Exemption) Regulations, 2016**

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section 233 of the Road Traffic Act, 2002, and on the recommendation of the Agency, the following Regulations are made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Obligatory Test Certificate) (Exemption) Regulations, 2016, and shall come into operation on the expiration of a period of thirty days from the date on which they are published in the *Gazette*.

2. The Minister may, upon application by an importer, dealer or manufacturer of a re-conditioned motor vehicle, exempt the importer, dealer or manufacturer of the re-conditioned motor vehicle from obtaining an obligatory test certificate for a period of three years.

Exemption

3. The Roads and Road Traffic (Obligatory Test Certificate) (Exemption) Regulations, 1989, are revoked.
