| 2. The principal Rules are amended by the revocation of rule 10 and the substitution therefor of the following: | Revocation

| 10. (1) The President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer and twelve other members of the Council shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting for a term of two years and shall continue in office until the close of the Annual General Meeting in the year in which the term expires. | Members of

| (2) A member elected to the Council is eligible for re-election. | |
| (3) A member of the Council may resign by writing to the Council and, on the acceptance of such resignation by the Council, that member's office shall become vacant. | |
| (4) The office of a member of the Council shall become vacant if the member— | |
| (a) has a mental disability that makes the member incapable of discharging the functions of the member's office; | |

(b) is adjudged bankrupt; or

(c) ceases to be a full member of the Association or abstains, without leave, from attending three consecutive meetings of the Council without good cause and a resolution of the Council is passed declaring the member's office vacant.

(5) A casual vacancy on the Council maybe filled by the election of another full member by the remaining members of the Council and a member so elected shall hold office for the remainder of the term of office of the Council.
