The Provincial and District Boundaries Act

(Laws, Volume 16, Cap. 286)

The Provincial and District Boundaries (Division) (Amendment) Order, 2017

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section 2 of the Provincial and District Boundaries Act, the following Order is made:

1. This Order may be cited as the Provincial and District Boundaries (Division) (Amendment) Order, 2017, and shall be read as one with the Provincial and District Boundaries (Division) Order, 1996, in this Order referred to as the principal Order.

Title

2. The First Schedule to the principal Order is amended by the insertion in the appropriate place in the second column opposite—

Amendment of First Schedule

- (a) the Muchinga Province, of the following Districts:
 - (i) the Kanchibiya District; and
 - (ii) the Lavushimanda District; and
- (b) the Northern Province, of the following District: the Lunte District
- 3. The Second Schedule to the principal Order is amended by the—

Amendment of Second Schedule

- (a) deletion of the boundary descriptions of the Mporokoso District and the Mpika District and the substitution therefor of the boundary descriptions set out in the Appendix; and
- (b) insertion, in the appropriate places under—
 - (i) the Muchinga Province, of the boundary descriptions of the Kanchibiya District and the Lavushimanda District; and
 - (ii) the Northern Province, of the boundary description of the Lunte District; set out in the Appendix.

APPENDIX (Paragraph 3)

Kanchibiya District

Starting at a point south east of the Kalama Islands the boundary runs in a north-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 19 Kilometres to the confluence of the Munikashi River and an unnamed tributary; thence up this unnamed tributary to its source; thence in a northeasterly direction for approximately 9 Kilometres to the source of an unnamed tributary of the Chambeshi River, thence down this tributary to its confluence with the Chambeshi River, thence up the Chambeshi River to its confluence with the Mansha River, thence up the Mansha River to its confluence with the Lubabala River; thence up the Lubabala River to its confluence with the Kampemba Stream, thence up the Kampemba Stream to its source, thence in a south-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 9 Kilometres to the source of the Luwanya River; thence down the Luwanya River to its confluence with Chilongwe River, thence down the Chilongwe River to its confluence with the Kanchibiya River, thence down the Kanchibiya River to its confluence with the Ntunta River, thence up the Ntunta River to its source, thence in a southward direction to the source of the Manyowe River; thence down the Manyowe River to its confluence with the Lwitikila River in the Chibwa Swamp, thence up the Mulyangwa Stream to its source; thence in a southward direction to the confluence of the Mufubushi River and the Luchandazi River; thence in a south-westerly direction to the source of the Lumbatwa River; thence down the Lumbatwa River for a distance of approximately 12 Kilometres; thence in a western direction for approximately 8 Kilometres; thence in a north-western direction for a distance of approximately 12 Kilometres to a point south-east of the Kalama Islands, the point of starting.

Lavushimanda District

Starting at a point on the ZambiaCongo DR International boundary on the Luapula River, the boundary runs up the Luapula River for a distance of approximately 35 Kilometres; thence in a north-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 50 Kilometres to a point on the Lumbatwa River, thence further in a north-easterly direction for approximately 12 Kilometres to a point situated south-east of the Kalama Island; thence in a south-easterly direction for approximately 12 Kilometres, thence in an easterly direction for approximately 8 Kilometres, thence in a further south-easterly direction for approximately 12 Kilometres to a point on the Lumbatwa River; thence up the Lumbatwa River to its source for approximately 72 Kilometres (following the northeastern boundary of the Lavushi Manda National Park No 9) to a point on the Mufubushi River; thence up the Mufubushi River to a point where it cuts the RD 733 Road; thence along the RD 733 Road in a northeasterly direction joining the T2 Road (Great North Road) in a southern direction for approximately 6 Kilometres near the source of the Mutinondo River; thence down the Mutinondo River for approximately 50 Kilometres to its confluence with an unnamed stream on the southern banks; thence in a south-westerly direction to its source; thence in a southward direction to a point on an unnamed tributary of the Mwatishi River; thence down the unnamed tributary to its confluence with the Mwatishi River, thence down the Mwatishi River to its confluence with the Mupamadzi River; thence up the Mupamadzi River to its confluence with an unnamed stream just opposite the Chinkoma River on the southern bank of the Mupamadzi River, thence up the unnamed stream to its source in a south-easterly direction, thence to the source of the Lubu River, thence down the Lubu River in the south-easterly direction for approximately 31 Kilometres; thence due south-eastwards to the source of an unnamed tributary of the Luangwa River, thence down the unnamed tributary of the Luangwa River to its confluence with the Luangwa River, thence down the Luangwa River to a point south of the watershed between the Mutisanse, Lusiwasi and Mulembo Rivers to the south and the Kapemba, Mupamadzi, Lukulu and Lulimala Rivers to the north; thence along the watershed between these rivers for approximately 197 Kilometres to the source of the Moboshi River; thence down the Moboshi River to its confluence with the Lulimalu River; thence down the Lulimalu River to its confluence with the Luapula River on the Zambia Congo DR International boundary, the point of starting.

Lunte District

Starting at the confluence of the Luangwa River and the Mwita Stream, the boundary runs up the Mwita Stream beyond its source to coordinates 223587.23 E, 8966306.73 N on the Muchinga Escarpment; thence eastwards along the Muchinga Escarpment for approximately 62 Kilometres; thence southwards towards the Mwale Ridge to a point on the D19 Road; thence eastwards along the D19 Road for approximately 50 Kilometres to a point at the source of the Kashingashi Stream; thence down the Kashingashi Stream to its confluence with the Mwiluzi Stream; thence down the Mwiluzi Stream to its confluence with the Luombe River, thence down the Luombe River to its confluence with the Kafubu River, thence up the Kafubu River to its source; thence westwards for approximately 7.5 Kilometres to the source of the eastern tributary of the Mwelekumbe River, thence down the Mwelekumbe River to its confluence with the Lukulu River, thence down the Lukulu River to its confluence with the Lubala River, thence up the Lubala River to its confluence with the Matipe Stream; thence up the Matipe Stream to its source; thence southwards for approximately 2 Kilometres to the source of the Lubushi Stream; thence down the Lubushi Stream to its confluence with the Mayebwe Stream; thence up the Mayebwe Stream to its source; thence along the southern base of the Mpalapata Hills to the source of the Fitaba Stream; thence down the Fitaba Stream to its confluence with the Lubansenshi River; thence up the Lubansenshi River to its confluence with the Buchende Stream; thence up the Buchende Stream to its source; thence westwards for approximately 7 kilometres to the source of the Ngona River, thence down the Ngona River to its confluence with the Kalungwishi River, thence down the Kalungwishi River to its confluence with the Fisaka River, thence up the Fisaka River to its source; thence in a north-westerly direction to the source of the Ichibumbye River; thence down the Ichibumbye River to its confluence with the Luangwa River; thence up the Luangwa River to its confluence with the Mwita Stream, the point of starting.

Mpika District

Starting at the source of the Luwanya River, the boundary runs in an easterly direction to the source of the Itulo River, thence down the Itulo River to its confluence with the Kanchibiya River, thence down the Kanchibiya River to its confluence with the Kanyelele River, thence up the Kanyelele River to its source; thence in an easterly and southerly direction for a distance approximately 10 Kilometres through the Mukowonshi Trigonometrical Beacon to Mulumewangombe Hill; thence in a southerly direction to the confluence of the Kabale River and the Kamisengo Stream; thence in a southeasterly direction for approximately 8 Kilometres to the confluence of the Mukungwa Stream and the Mwatesi River near the T2 Road (Great North Road); thence in a southwesterly direction for approximately 6 Kilometres along the T2 Road near the source of the Mwatesi River; thence in an easterly direction to the source of the Kapamba River; thence down the Kapamba River to its intersection with the southwest boundary of Farm 1367 Kapamba River to its intersection with the south-west boundary beacon C786 situated on the right bank of the Isase Stream; thence down the Isase Stream to its confluence with the Kapamba River; thence down the Kapamba River to its confluence with the Munyamadzi River, thence up the Munyamadzi River to its confluence with the Mwanswa River, thence up the Mwanswa River to its source; thence in an easterly direction for approximately 5 Kilometres to the source of the Chabala Stream; thence down the Chabala Stream to its confluence with the Mwaleshi River, thence up the Mwaleshi River to its confluence with the Chitwe Stream; thence up the Chitwe Stream to its source; thence in a northerly direction for approximately 8 Kilometres to the confluence of the Lufila River and the Mumba Stream, thence up the Mumba Stream to its source; thence in an easterly direction for approximately 4 Kilometres to the source of the Mumbwe River, thence down the Mumbwe River to its confluence with the Luswa River, thence down the Luswa River to its confluence with the Lufila River; thence down the Lufila River to its confluence with the Luangwa River, thence down the Luangwa River for a distance of approximately 172 kilometres to an unnamed tributary on the western side, thence up this unnamed tributary in a northwesterly direction for approximately 30 Kilometres to its source; thence in a further north-westerly direction to a point almost near the confluence of the Katumbu

River and the Lubi River, thence up the Lubi River to its source; thence in a north-westerly direction to the source of an unnamed tributary of the Mupamadzi River, thence down the unnamed tributary to its confluence with the Mupamadzi River; thence down the Mupamadzi River to its confluence with the Mwatishi River, thence up the Mwatishi River for approximately 7 Kilometres; thence in a northward direction for approximately 8 Kilometres to a point on the Mutinondo River, thence up the Mutinondo River to its source near the T2 Road (Great North Road); thence in a northerly direction for approximately 6 Kilometres to the RD 733 Road; thence due westwards along this road to a point on the Mufubushi River, thence down the Mufubushi River for approximately 14 Kilometres; thence in a northwesterly direction for approximately 9 Kilometres; thence in a northeasterly direction to the source of the Luchandazi River, thence down the Luchandazi River to its confluence with the Mufubushi River, thence due northwards to the source of the Mulyangwa Stream; thence down the Mulyangwa Stream through the Chibwa Swamp to the confluence of the Lwitikila River and the Manyowe River, thence up the Manyowe River in the northern direction to its source; thence due north to the source of the Ntunta River, thence down the Ntunta River to its confluence with the Kanchibiya River; thence up the the Kanchibiya River to its confluence with the Chilongwe River, thence up the Chilongwe River to its confluence with the Luwanya River; thence up the Luwanya River to its source, the point of starting.

Mporokoso District

Starting at the confluence of the Kalungwishi River with the Itabu River, the boundary runs up the Itabu River to a point on coordinates 131076.58 E, 8968037.40 N, 3 kilometres north of the Yangumwila Falls; thence northeastwards for approximately 15 Kilometres to a point on the Mukubwe River on UTM coordinates 143322.90 E, 8978179.85 N, 6.5 Kilometres north of the Lupupa Falls; thence along the Muchinga Escarpment for approximately 90 Kilometres to a point on UTM coordinates 223587.32 E, 8966306.73 N, approximately 2 Kilometres north of the source of the Mwita Stream; thence southwards to the source of the Mwita Stream; thence down the Mwita Stream to its confluence with the Luangwa River; thence down the Luangwa River to its confluence with the Ichibumbye Stream; thence up the Ichibumbye Stream to its source; thence southwards to the source of the Fisaka Stream; thence down the Fisaka Stream to its confluence with the Kalungwishi River; thence down the Kalungwishi River to its confluence with the Itabu River, the point of starting.
